RE: Update to Notice of Data Security Event / Evolve Bank & Trust ("the Bank")

Dear Attorney General:

We are following up on our notice dated July 8, 2024, in which we provided notice that the Bank had detected and contained a security event that impacted the personal information of some Idaho residents. As we noted in the July 8th notice, the Bank's investigation into affected personal information was ongoing. It is now substantially complete. We are writing to inform you that our investigation has identified approximately 32,398 additional state residents. In addition to providing substitute notice on July 8, 2024<sup>1</sup>, the Bank is notifying these state residents directly where email address is available.
