RE: PowerSchool Cybersecurity Incident

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to notify you that Parma School District #137 has experienced a data breach that resulted in some student and teacher personal information from our student information system (SIS) being compromised.

On Tuesday, January 7th, our IT department was notified by PowerSchool, our SIS provider, "that an unauthorized party gained access to certain PowerSchool Student Information System ("SIS") customer data using a compromised credential." Following this notification, our IT staff reviewed data access logs and found that this party had exported data from two tables in our SIS, the Student table and the Teacher table.

On Thursday, January 9th, our Superintendent, Dale Layne, notified our board members so that they were aware of the data breach. We were able to notify our current employees and student families today, January 10th, of the data breach.

Per our IC § 33-133, IC § 28-51-105, as well as Parma School District Policy 681.50, accept this letter as our notification of a cybersecurity breach.
