## Re: Notice of Data Security Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

This notice is provided on behalf of my client, Jefferson Joint School District #251 ("Jefferson"). On January 7, 2025, Jefferson received notification from its third-party vendor, PowerSchool, regarding a cybersecurity incident that impacted Jefferson's data maintained in PowerSchool. PowerSchool provides Jefferson's Student Information System, which is used to manage education information related to students and staff. Upon learning about this incident, Jefferson immediately began an investigation with the assistance of legal counsel and a nationally recognized cyber security and digital forensics firm. On January 14, 2025, the cyber security firm working with Jefferson staff confirmed that the data affected by the PowerSchool incident included personal information as defined in Idaho Code § 28-51-104(5), related to certain former Jefferson students. The personal information affected included Idaho residents' names and Social Security numbers. Therefore, Jefferson is reporting a breach of the security of the system, pursuant to Idaho Code § 28-51-105(1), resulting from the cybersecurity incident impacting PowerSchool.

Jefferson will continue to investigate and will ensure that proper written notice is provided to the impacted individuals, as required by law, together with an offer of complimentary credit monitoring where appropriate. We will keep you informed of any significant developments as the investigation continues.
